

Dress Code Reminder

What: A friendly reminder that scholars must be in dress code. Please refer to the handbook or one pager on the back for dress code details.

When: All scholars are expected to be in dress code by September. As a courtesy to families, we are working to help them. Please don't use what other scholars wear as an excuse not to be in dress code. We need all parents support to help make this work!

Why: Dress code is essential to ensure scholar safety, as well as to support the professional/college going culture of our school. If you have a need, please call the front office.

Out of Dress Code Procedure: Families of scholars who are out of dress code will be called and asked to bring them proper attire. Scholars out of dress code will be documented as such and may lose privileges for repeated infractions, up to detention or ISS.

TriEA Student Dress Code

The purpose of the dress code is to ensure that each student is dressed in clothing conducive to promoting a learning environment. Clothing should be safe and comfortable. Clothing that is too tight, too short, or that reveals undergarments, is not appropriate for school. Clothing should be clean and in good repair.

PANTS / SLACKS

- Pants should be **navy** in color only.
- Pants should not have holes, be frayed, or drag the ground.
- Pants should be solid in color, with no stripes, two-tones, or extra decorations.
- Pants must be khaki or cargo style.
- 6th-8th graders must wear a plain black belt, woven or flat, with a small silver buckle.
 - Pants should be worn **at the waist**.
- Pants should be cotton, cotton twill, or cotton-polyester blend.
- No jeans of any type may be worn.
- No stretch material may be worn.
- No shorts, capris, or skirts to ensure outdoor safety.

SHIRTS:

- Must be shades of blue and green (bright colors preferable)
- Shirts must be a polo style.
- Shirts must be worn with all buttons closed.
- 6th-8th graders shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Primary scholar's shirts should also be tucked in or may not exceed the length of the palm of their hands.
- Shirts must be a solid color with no extra decorations.
- If a shirt has a logo, it must be less than a quarter in diameter.
- Undershirts may be worn, but must be white and unseen.

JACKETS / COATS:

- Coats and jackets must be blue or black with a zipper or buttons.
- Coats and jackets must not have a hood.
- A sweatshirt or hoodie is not permitted.
- As we are an environmental school, we ask that you check the forecast and send your child to school with the proper outerwear needed to spend time outdoors.

SHOES:

- Shoes must be black sneakers with black laces.
- If your child can not yet tie their shoes, Velcro is suggested.
- Socks must be solid white and long preferred.

MISCELLANEOUS:

- Wearing jewelry is not recommended. If worn, earrings must be smaller than a pencil eraser. If necklaces are worn, must be small and tucked inside shirt. No other jewelry permitted.
- Hairstyles must be clean and neat with no shaved in designs or Mohawks.
- Gentleman scholars may not have hair longer than shoulders.
- Backpacks may not have wheels without doctor's note.
- PreK-1 scholar's names should be on the shoulder strap of the backpack.
